Progress Monitoring Plan — Saratoga and LA/LHHS

The goals we are monitoring this year:

- Saratoga: Our students will become more proficient and confident writers at their grade level
- LA/LHHS: Students will be able to organize and present ideas effectively to write extended responses to a prompt

We chose these goals because:

 State and school data revealed that students need additional support in organizing their ideas and elaborating on their writing



Progress Monitoring Plan: Saratoga and LHHS/LA

We will use these tools to collect data on our progress toward our goal:

Student Writing Samples

- Collection of writing samples winter and spring
- Writing rubrics to formatively assess student writing to identify areas of strength and areas for improvement





The Data Shows ...

Saratoga

Winter writing samples showed:

- Students need additional support in writing introductions and conclusions for their writing
- Grades 6-8: Lack of supporting evidence connected back to the writing topic.
- Students need additional support in elaborating on their topic

LA/LHHS

Winter writing samples showed:

- Students need additional support in organizing their writing (clear topic; progression of ideas from beginning to end
- Students need support in citing supporting evidence on the topic in their writings



Our Next Steps ...

Saratoga

Writing lessons designed to focus on:

- Organizing student ideas and thoughts to create clear and concise writing that effectively conveys to readers their ideas (graphic organizers)
- Introduction and conclusions
- Increase writing instruction at home with the support of teachers

LA/LHHS

Writing lessons designed to focus on:

- Organizing student ideas and thoughts to create clear and concise writing that effectively conveys to readers their ideas (writing graphic organizers)
- Integrating evidence from source materials into their writing
- Reviewing and evaluating released student writing samples from the state
